



General Parade Rules and Regulations

- ❖ Entries must be done in good taste and be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the parade.
- ❖ Safety is Important! -to prevent children from running out onto the street:
 - **Throwing candy into the crowd is prohibited.** (you may walk alongside the entry and HAND candy out.
 - Any entry consisting of a large motor vehicle or preceded by horses must be led by a participant on foot
 - Please use caution as you travel down the parade route.
- ❖ Each organization will be allowed one unit (i.e. vehicle pulling flatbed, one convertible, etc.)
 - A walker must accompany all entries on each side.
 - Each entry should stay approximately one car length behind the entry directly ahead of it and travel between 5 and 10 miles per hour.
 - Clean-up personnel must follow all entries that involve live animals.
- ❖ Do not park on Main Street the morning of the parade.
- ❖ Semi-trucks and trailers are not allowed in the parade.
- ❖ Alcohol is strictly prohibited on the parade route.
- ❖ Handing out drinks, either hot or cold, is prohibited.
- ❖ Parade will be limited to 75 entries; NO Exceptions!
- ❖ Failure to adhere to the rules and regulations may affect your future participation in Downtown Parades.
